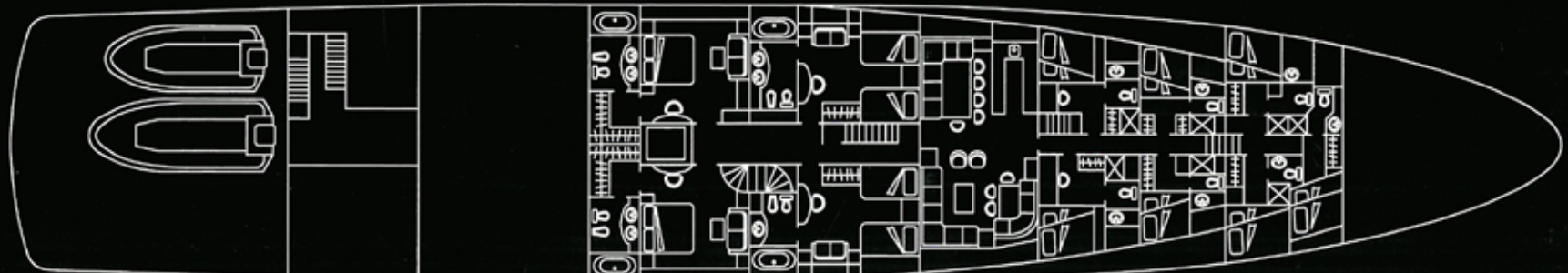
Sun Deck
